Alphonse Zozime Tamekamta was born in 1978 in Balepo (Cameroon). He holds degrees on Secondary Education from the Education School of Yaounde; he studied History of International Relations (Bachelor, Master, Post-Graduate) at the University of Yaounde I and Political Science at the University of Yaounde II. He received his PhD in 2016 in History of International Relations from the University of Yaounde on "The Economic and Cultural Factors of Socio-Political Crises in the CEMAC Zone (1960-2010)". He is interested in issues of African integration, governance, violent extremism, conflicts and security in the Central African Economic and Monetary Community (CEMAC) area. He works as a researcher and an expert at several international think tanks: GRIP (Brussels), ROP (Montreal), Thinking Africa (Abidjan). He was a researcher at the Multi-annual Observatory on Socio-political and Security Issues in Equatorial Africa and the Gulf of Guinea Islands (a project commissioned by the French Ministry of Defence) and is a consultant to the Levy-Mwanawasa Regional Centre for Democracy and Good Governance in Lusaka (Zambia), endorsed by the International Conference on the Great Lakes Region. He is the co-founder and Deputy Director of the African Research Centre for Peace and Sustainable Development -CARPADD- Montreal (Canada). He is also a writer and the author of some 30 scientific articles and eight books published by L'Harmattan, Edilivre, Editions Cheikh Anta Diop, and PAF.
