

Dr Séverine BLAISE

Séverine Blaise, born in 1975, is Lecturer at the Department of Law, Economics and Management of the University of New Caledonia in Nouméa since 2007. Her main areas of research are Economics of Development and International Economics, and her minor areas are Economics of Sustainable Development and Economics of Culture. Among others she works on efficiency of aid in the process of development of East Asia and the Pacific countries, including the phenomenon of regionalisation and the complementary role of direct foreign investment; she focuses on the originality of Japanese aid as well as the links between the flows of public and private capital in the region. She received a Doctorate in Economics from the University of the Mediterranean (Aix-Marseille) in 1999-2004; she also holds a Master's degree in Economics of Development from the Institute of Economic Research of the Hitotsubashi University in Tokyo, and a post-graduate degree (DEA) in International and Industrial Economics of the University of the Mediterranean (1997-1998). Since 2007, she teaches at the University of New Caledonia, is a researcher at the Centre for New Studies on the Pacific, and a Visiting Lecturer at the National Australian University in Canberra. She also held several positions as a trainer, researcher or lecturer in France, Japan and Australia. Her Doctorate thesis was on "*Efficiency of Development Aid: The Case of East Asia*" and her Master's thesis on: "*The Effectiveness of Japan's Aid: A Microeconomic Evaluation in China*".
